As I get settled into the Holy Season of Pentecost, make plans and preparations for summer and possible vacation time, I try each year to read something profound and life changing, that will give me perspective to reflect, as I weed the garden, spend valuable family time, paddle on the water, or cycle on the road. This year I have chosen *Made for Goodness*, by Desmond Tutu and his daughter Mpho Tutu. As I break open the first few pages, I know this book will challenge me and transform me. I share with you a few lines:

Second, we are perfectly loved with a love that requires nothing of us, so we can stop “being good” and live into the goodness that is our essence. It is an invitation to wholeness that leads to flourishing for all of us.”
